

Life seems to go in circles. Every day you wake up, get ready, go to work or school, eat your meals, do your job, go home, have a little fun, attend to a few things, get ready for bed, put your head on the pillow, and go to sleep. The following morning, you wake up and do the same thing all over again. Your days repeat themselves. Weeks, months, and years repeat themselves. History repeats itself. The earth goes through its own cycles of repetition.

And sometimes, when we step back and reflect on the cycles of life, it prompts us to ask ourselves, "Is there any meaning in all of this activity? Is there any meaning in this rat race of life?" That is the question that the Preacher wrestles through in chapter 1 of Ecclesiastes. **Can we discover value in the cycles of life?** He walks us through some wise facts of life that help us wrestle through this question.

#### Wise Fact #1: Life is Vapid (vs. 1-2)

- Life is <u>utterly</u> vapid (*hevel*).
- Life is <u>completely</u> vapid (*hevel*).

Can meaning be found in the passing cycles of life?

## Wise Fact #2: Mankind is Vapid (vs. 3-4).

- Generations come.
- Generations go.

Value in the circle of life is found in God alone, the <u>Creator</u> of mankind.

#### Wise Fact #3: Creation is cyclical (vs. 5-7).

- The sun <u>races</u> through its cycles (v. 5).
- The wind blows thorough its cycles (v. 6).

## Wise Fact #4: Life is often unsatisfying (v. 8).

## Wise Fact #5: Nothing is actually new (vs. 9-10).

- Things that are happening now will happen again (v. 9b).
- Things that are happening now <u>already</u> happened before (v. 10).
