



## Lesson 8: Growing as One – Walk Together

### Ephesians 4:1-16

Who you are will impact what you do, or at least it should. Chapters 1-3 of Ephesians show a believer what God has done for them and follows all of this up with a very hefty command: walk worthy of your calling. But the way Paul immediately applies this truth might surprise us. He doesn't tell us to clean up our immorality or watch the way we speak, at least not yet. He doesn't begin by telling us not to steal or lie, although he will. He begins this section by addressing the way believer interact with each other. Why? Because the glory of the gospel is seen in the reconciliation of believers with God and with others, and we need other Christians to help us so that we can walk worthy of the gospel. No one can go it alone, we all need help!

#### PAUL SHOWS US THE NEED FOR UNITY (vv 1-6)

- **Unity requires \_\_\_\_\_ (vv 1-3).**
  - Unity requires \_\_\_\_\_ – being “lowly-minded,” i.e. not thinking much of oneself.
  - Unity requires \_\_\_\_\_ – controlling anger in dealing with others.
