STEP 2: INTERCESSION

Matthew 6:10 — *Your kingdom come, Your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.*

To intercede on the behalf of another is a selfless act of service. It is through prayer that we can declare to God our dependence on Him to work and our desire to do His will.

Intercession for the Family – *“Your will be done” in the lives of my family*

- Hedge of Protection (For Safety) – Job 1:10
- Hedge of Thorns (From Moral impurity) – Hosea 2:6
- Be ye holy: for I am Holy (Being) – 1 Peter 1:16
- Walk in the Spirit (Doing) – Gal 5:16,25
- Conformed into the Image of Christ – Rom 8:28

Intercession for the Laborers – *“Your will be done” with Your Christian workers*

- The Lord's Harvest – Matt 9:38
- The Lord's Labor Pool – Rom 12:1
- The Lord's Choice – Isaiah 6:5-8

Intercession for the Church Leadership – *“Your will be done” in my church*

- That the leadership would truly prepare the saints to do the work of the ministry (Eph 4:11-12, 2 Cor 5:18, Heb:14)
- That the leadership would be spiritually qualified at all times (1 Tim 3, Titus 1)
- That they be in communion with God to do God's will in leading the church

Intercession for a Lost World – *“Your will be done” in my evangelism*

- You have been chosen by God to be an instrument of reconcile the lost to God through Christ – 2 Cor 5:18-20
- The end of those that are not reconciled to God will be eternal torment where the fire is not quenched and eternity alone without God – Mark 9:43, 1 John 5:11-13
- God has promised never to leave us alone – Matt 28:20
- The Holy Spirit is already at work convicting those without Christ – John 16:8
- “How dare we speak to men about God before we speak to God about men” – E. M. Bounds

Intercession for the Government – *“Your will be done” in the government*

- That God will use the government so that we can live peaceable lives – 1 Tim 2:1-2
- Rest under the authority that God has given – Rom 13:1-4
- The Lord has the heart of the king in His hand – Pro 21:1

Intercession for Special Request that God has Laid on your Heart

- Pray for God's plan to be accomplished – James 4:3
- Have the spirit of Christ – “Not My will but Thine be done.”
- Pray Scripture Promises
- Ask in Jesus Name – John 14:13
- Ask what you desire – Matt 7:7

STEP 3: PETITION AND DEPENDENCE

Matthew 6:11 — *Give us this day our daily bread.*

Our petitions reveal our dependence and declare our thankfulness for the daily provision of God. 1 Thes. 5:18 says, "In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you."

Spiritual Warfare

- Come to God declaring your dependence on Him to deliver you from temptation and sin.
- Eph. 6:11-18, "Put on the whole armour of God."

The Armor of God

- *Belt of truth* – Who God is and who you are in Christ
- *Breastplate of righteousness* – Be holy (walk with a repentant attitude/short sin account)
- Gospel of peace – Be peacemakers with all men (yield your rights and expectations to God)
- *Shield of faith* – Believe God (trust in God's sovereignty, His love, His plan, and His power)
- *Helmet of salvation* – Genuine personal relationship with Jesus Christ
- *Sword of the Spirit* – Obey promptings of the Holy Spirit
- *Prayer* – Talk with the Father (seek His face)
