


Session 3: As You Like It?—Relating to Others By Imitating the Example of Christ

1. As children of God, we should share the same mindset. (#1+5 above)

a. By refusing to equate unity with unanimity in all points.
uniformity

b. By sharing the same source of teaching. (Acts 2:42; Col. 3:15-16)
*The Word of Christ

c. By sharing the same example. (Phil. 2:5; 1 Pt. 2:21; 4:1)

*Jesus Christ... the mindset of humble ministry → This is the mindset we

should share
b/c our leader
had it.

d. By rejecting the contemporary spirit of individualism.
(Phil. 2:4)

This is NOT the
church of Christ
we are supposed
to work in & out of our
relationship w/ Jesus
Christ; therefore,
we can't do that
w/ those who
are in Christ.

- "Networked individualism"
- * we chose our groups / communities / network
 - * It's just information, not meaningful interaction
 - * we can control those groups by deleting, removing, blocking, unfriending, etc.

2. As children of God, we should share in the same experiences. (#2+4 above)

- a. By endeavoring to see life from the viewpoint of others. Rom. 12:15

Feel w/
others. (Phil. 2:4) I have to get my view off myself
to sympathize. Ex. 2 Pt. 3:7

- b. By sacrificially reaching out to meet the needs of others.

* Active

* Self-sacrificial

* Move beyond sympathetic

thoughts ("words of compassion") + add
in works of compassion (cf. James 2).

- c. By refusing to become hardened by the sheer volume of the needs around us.

- d. By rehearsing our own experience of God's compassion.

GOSPEL

- e. By imitating the example of our Great High Priest, Jesus Christ.

* He is no longer here to do this; He has entrusted the meeting of needs to us.

3. As children of God, we share the same family. (#3 above)

* This is the source or Spring from w/c #1+2 flow: We must have a natural family affection.

- a. Because we have the same Father.

(E Ph. 1:3)

We must understand our family connection.

- b. By means of the new birth.

(E Ph. 1:3; John. 3:12) — so, not only vertical family relationships,
but horizontal, as well.

- c. Regardless of our own personal preferences.

* like our physical family, we didn't get to choose our spiritual family. → but God was wise and purposeful in his choosing

As children of God we should share the same mindset and share in the same experiences because we share the same family.
